SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

AUTHORITY The event will be conducted under the International Sporting Code of the F.I.A., the National Competition Rules (NCR) of the Confederation of Australian Motor Sport Limited (CAMS), the Speed Events Standing Regulations, Victorian Hillclimb Championship Standing Regulations, the CAMS Victoria NGK Junior Pentathlon Series Regulations, these Supplementary Regulations, and any further regulations or instructions which may be issued, and shall be subject to CAMS PERMIT NUMBER 312/2801/02.

The event will be conducted under and in accordance with CAMS OH&S and Risk Management Policies, which can be found on the CAMS website at www.cams.com.au

THE EVENT The event will be a State Championship Hillclimb and **ROUND 1** of the **ALCO BATTERIES 2012 VICTORIAN HILLCLIMB CHAMPIONSHIP** to be conducted at Bryant Park, Haunted Hills, Bill Schulz Drive, Yallourn on Saturday January 28, 2012. The event will be a **Twilight Hillclimb**, commencing at 1.00 p.m. and concluding at approximately 7.00 p.m.. The event is a round of the 2012 NGK Junior Pentathlon Series.

ENTRIES Entries will open **with the publication of these regulations**, and will close at close of business on **Tuesday, January 24, 2012**. Entry fee will be **\$99 (Junior entry fee for drivers under the age of 18 on the day of the event will be \$50)**. Entry fees include GST. Cheques and Money Orders should be made payable to the Gippsland Car Club Incorporated. Entry forms must be completed in full, accompanied by the entry fee, and be lodged with the Secretary of the Meeting.

The Promoters have arranged Public Risk Insurance to the requirements of Appendix I of the current CAMS Manual of Motor Sport. The Promoters reserve the right to stipulate the number of entries for the Meeting, and select entries in excess of such number at their absolute discretion. The maximum number of entries shall be 120, accepted in order of receipt. The Promoter reserves the right to refuse entry in accordance with NCR83.

COMPETITION Official runs will commence at 1.00 p.m. on Saturday, January 28, 2012 – the number of official runs will be notified at the Driver's Briefing.

PERSONS ELIGIBLE The event shall be open to members of clubs affiliated with CAMS who are holders of a CAMS Level 2S or higher Licence.

SCRUTINY Scrutiny will commence at 9.00 a.m. and conclude at 12.00 noon on Saturday, January 28, 2012. All cars must be scrutineered and passed for competition prior to the commencement of competition on each day. CAMS Licences, Competition Records and current Club membership cards must be produced at Scrutiny, and on request during the meeting. **All vehicles competing in the 2012 Victorian Hillclimb Championship must have a CAMS Log Book**, which must be presented at Scrutiny. Entries will be accepted from competitors/vehicles without a CAMS Log Book, but these entries will only be accepted after all Log Booked entries have been accepted. Such competitors will not score points in the 2012 Victorian Hillclimb Championship.

DRIVERS BRIEFING The attendance of all drivers is required at a Drivers Briefing to be held at 12.40 p.m. on Saturday, January 28, 2012. Drivers who fail to attend such briefings may be liable for a penalty imposed by the Stewards. The starting order and starting procedures will be advised at the Drivers Briefing. Any changes to the running order during the event are at the discretion of the Clerk of the Course.

TIMING Timing will be electronic, and be to one hundredth of a second. Event winners will be those competitors with the fastest time for a single run in each class. In the event of a tie, the next fastest official time of each competitor will determine the event winner. Timekeepers will be considered Judges of Fact.

PROTESTS Any protests must be lodged in accordance with Part XII of the NCR.

ABANDONMENT The Promoters reserve the right to abandon, postpone or cancel the meeting in accordance with NCR 59. The meeting will be postponed to a date to be determined if a **TOTAL FIRE BAN** has been declared for the **WEST AND SOUTH GIPPSLAND FIRE DISTRICT** for the day of the event.

SAFETY - DRIVER Drivers must wear a helmet to a standard listed in the CAMS Manual of Motor Sport, and be deemed by the scrutineers of the event to be in a suitable condition for motorsport use, non flammable clothing, suitable footwear, and goggles or visors with lens other than glass in open car. All apparel, including helmets, must comply with the requirements of Schedule D of the current CAMS Manual).

SAFETY - CARS The attention of competitors is drawn to Schedule A and B of the current CAMS Manual of Motor Sport (General Requirements for Cars and Drivers) in which all vehicle requirements are listed in detail. Silencers are not mandatory, but vehicles must not exceed a noise limit of 95dB(A). Vehicles must be fitted with a fire extinguisher complying with Section 6, Schedule H of the current CAMS Manual. Competitors are reminded that the possession and use of Halon/BCF fire extinguishers, other than where specific approval has been given by the E.P.A., is prohibited. Fuel must be in accordance with Schedule G of the current CAMS Manual.

ANTI-DOPING POLICY During any event, consumption of alcoholic beverages in the paddock, pits or any other portion of the competition venue under the control of the officials is expressly forbidden until all practice or competition activity is concluded for each day. Any driver or crew member who is found to be affected by alcohol on the day of the event or practice therefore shall not be permitted to participate, Refer NCR 145A of the current CAMS Manual. In addition, the persons concerned will be subject to the Articles of the Standard Operating Procedure for Alcohol Testing and CAMS Anti-Doping Policy. Competitors, crews or officials may be randomly tested for alcohol or other drugs at any time during the event by a CAMS Accredited Testing Official (CATO).

OTHER PROHIBITED SUBSTANCES. The CAMS Anti-Doping Policy, as appears in the CAMS Manual of Motor Sport and as amended from time to time, is recognised as an integral component of the NCR and is duly authorised as such. In any area where the National Competition Rules and the CAMS Anti-Doping Policy conflict, the CAMS Anti-Doping Policy will take precedence.

Classes may, at the Promoters discretion, be combined where there are less than three entries in a class. Where there are sufficient entries, further classes may be created (e.g., Formula Libre up to 500cc, etc.). Competitors in Historic – Other must provide a Certificate of Description for their vehicle.

AWARDS Trophies will be awarded to the person achieving fastest time of day, and to the fastest and second fastest time in each class. Further awards may be made, and these will be notified to competitors in any further information that may be forwarded to competitors and/or at the Drivers Briefing.

TRACK CONFIGURATION This event will be conducted on the **Clockwise Track** configuration, over a distance of approximately 1238 metres.

COMPETING CARS Competing cars must be kept in the paddock area during the running of the meeting. All competitors will be allocated a numbered pit bay, and such number will be notified in the acceptance of entry. Competitors trailers must be parked in the trailer park or other designated areas, and must not be parked in spectator areas. All competitors should enter the circuit by the gate marked Competitors.

ACCEPTANCE OF ENTRIES Notification of the acceptance of entry will be forwarded to all competitors.

GARAGES A number of garages will be available for hire for the event. These will be allocated on a first come basis. The cost of the garage hire is \$70. The cost of the garage hire must be included with the entry fee. Unsuccessful applicants will have their money refunded in full.
